FEB 10, 1905	FRI	<i>Rec'd this book from Wade. Snowed this morning but cleared off warm. Albert has gone to Glines' Place. 4o'clock snowing and blowing . Bought package of B H ____ of Frank Downs. This evening Oscar &amp; Albert playing checkers.</i>
FEB 11, 1905	SAT	<i>The wind blew fearfully all last night and is today blowing a gale. Bessie has gone to Grange meeting. Oscar is fixing boxes for the cattle. Albert went down after oil. Mrs. D.B. Austin. Mrs. A ____ Holman died. Very cold tonight.</i>
FEB 12, 1905	SUN	<i>Did not go to church. It is snowing this afternoon.</i>
FEB 13, 1905	MON	<i>Washed. Snowing and blowing this afternoon. Albert went to Glines Place after wood.</i>
FEB 14, 1905	TUE	<i>Bought sugar ____ of C 75cts. Albert wnet to Glines' Place for wood. L ____ at Grange Hall.</i>
FEB 15, 1905	WED	<i>Albert went to Glines Place. Etta ____ died this morning.</i>
FEB 16, 1905	THU	<i>Masquerade Ball tonight. Albert went to Glines Place after wood. R Horne &amp; Salla G got to the ball tonight. Had letter from Sarah today.</i>
FEB 17, 1905	FRI	<i>Albert went to Gline's Place. A man called this morn to see if we would give him dinner and let him work to pay for same. So after dinner he cut wood.</i>
FEB 18, 1905	SAT	<i>Cold and windy. Might rain. Did not yet in until 9 o'clock.</i>
FEB 19, 1905	SUN	<i>Cold</i>
FEB 20, 1905	MON	<i>This morning it was 15 degrees below zero. At two o'clock it was 30 degrees above. Albert went to Gline's Place for wood. C.L. Dillingham called. I paid subscription for 75 m ____.</i>
FEB 21, 1905	TUE	<i>Rose and I washed today; very pleasant and spring like. Bought gram of flour paid \$2.33. Oscar went out in the shed and cut and brought in some wood. Had not been cut for 5 weeks.</i>
FEB 22, 1905	WED	<i>Oscar did part of chores at barn today. Albert went to Glines Place; had letter from Harriett.</i>
FEB 23, 1905	THU	<i>Pleasant and spring like. Had papers from mother. Pd for groceries 90 cts. The Sabbath School had a supper in the church and rooms tonight. Wrote to Sarah this evening.</i>
FEB 24, 1905	FRI	<i>Warm and pleasant. Christiane called his afternoon. They received \$14. for their supper last night. Rose &amp; Lola have gone to the dance at Opera House.</i>
FEB 25, 1905	SAT	<i>Pleasant. Oscar went to village today. Saw G. Roberts, Bessie saw Louisa at Grange meeting.</i>
FEB 26, 1905	SUN	<i>Went to church quite a lot. Then stopped to S School. Christiana spoke also Mitchell. Em Knight called after church.</i>
FEB 27, 1905	MON	<i>Rather cold and windy. Washed. Had a letter from Sarah. Then Lucy entered the hospital Thursday and was operated upon Friday. Operation successful. Bought tea. Paid 25 cts.</i>
FEB 28, 1905	TUE	<i>Albert went to the Falls after barrels. Got 50. Picking over apples this afternoon. Dance at Grange Hall.</i>
MAR 1, 1905	WED	<i>Cold. Albert and his father picking over apples. Had a letter from Sarah telling of Sucie; think she is coming out all right.</i>
MAR 2, 1905	THU	<i>Oscar &amp; Albert picking over apples. Went to C.A. Received for supper \$7.95. ____ on Supper Louise. Emma Randall and Mrs. Pease called in ____; all well.</i>
MAR 3, 1905	FRI	<i>Pleasant. Mrs. Tucker called. Bought up some green beans. Paid 25 cts.</i>
MAR 4, 1905	SAT	<i>Quite warm. Oscar has been heading up apples. Albert &amp; Vivian have been getting their saw frame ready to saw wood.</i>
MAR 5, 1905	SUN	<i>Went to church and S. School. Rec'd "Enoch walked with God" Genesis.</i>
MAR 6, 1905	MON	<i>Rather cold. Had a letter from Caroline with milk blanks.</i>
